### The Triduum

What is the Triduum? It is one service that extends from Maundy Thursday through the Easter Vigil. We break it into three parts: Maundy Thursday (7pm), Good Friday (noon), and Easter Vigil (7pm), but it is really a journey through the last days of Jesus' life, his crucifixion, and the waiting for the resurrection. Please consider bringing your children to these services - we will have special bulletins for them, and the Easter Vigil is where we release the Alleluia balloons.



Easter Sunday we will have our traditional Easter Egg Hunt and crafts in the parish hall following the 10:30 service. There will be NO SUNDAY SCHOOL on Easter Sunday.
